Parental Consent Forms

Members under the age of 18 who are competing in a National Final must complete and return a Parental Consent Form to NFYFC 10 days prior to the competition. The form will be included with the Competitors notes, can be downloaded from the NFYFC website or is available from County Office.

Under 18 year old competitors representing Derbyshire in East Midlands Area (EMA) competitions may take the parental consent form with them on the day unless otherwise requested.

The Parental consent forms for members competing in county regional and club rounds is completed in duplicate at the same time as the membership renewal/application form. Clubs retain one copy (usually the club secretary) and the other is sent to county office. These forms are valid for all competitions until 31st August each year

Members are encouraged to complete the interest form even if they have done one for previous funding.
