



As from 1st March the penalty for using a handheld mobile phone or similar device while driving, or riding a motorcycle will double to 6 points and attract a £200 fine. Newly qualified drivers (first two years) as a consequence will have to retake their tests again. The rules are the same if you're stopped at traffic lights or queuing in traffic. It's also illegal to use a hand-held phone or similar device when supervising a learner driver or rider. Remember these rules also apply if you are driving a tractor or agricultural vehicle on the road.
