GUIDELINES FOR CLUB CHAIRMAN

- The Chairman is responsible to the club members for the management of the club and its programme.
- 2 Understand the concepts of the YFC and keep up to date with the latest developments at all levels in YFC.
- 3 Know your constitution and correct meeting procedure.
- Work with other club officers to ensure that child protection and health and safety requirements are met.
- 5 Encourage a good team spirit.
- 6 Use a little humour to relieve tension.
- Meet, support and discuss issues regularly with your fellow club officers and ensure that you are aware of the other officers' roles as well as your own.
- Welcome new members by speaking to them personally and ensuring someone will look after them until they become established. Speak to them at subsequent meetings.
- Welcome and give a good introduction to speakers and see they are adequately thanked

- Maintain control firmly but be courteous at all times to all people.
- Use your vote and casting vote sparingly and wisely.
- Always maintain an impartial outlook.
- 13 Always be punctual with meetings and be a good ambassador for your club at other meetings.
- Help future officers to learn the necessary skills.
- Whilst not making a meal of formality, use correct committee procedures so that the club is an example to members on how to make collective decisions.
- 16 Keep discussions relevant.
- Ensure that every meeting has an agenda which has been thought out and prepared. Ensure you know what you want to achieve.
- 18 Use group discussion to gather all your club members' suggestions to take to county meetings and remember to report back the outcomes.

- Make sure that club activities are properly insured by checking unusual activities with our YFC insurers.
- Contact the other local youth groups as some of their facilities can help your club.
- 21 Set a personal example to club members.
- When in doubt consult the Club Leader or YFC office.
